## **Article I**

(Name of the Club)

The name of this club will be Team Programming Club.

## **Article II**

(Purpose of Club)

The Club has been organized to give students the tools needed to compete in hackathons and programming competitions.

## **Article III**

(Authority)

Treasurer – Keeps financial record.

Project Manager - Helps with programming problems.

Promoter - Advertises the club.

(Elections)

Officers shall serve 1 term(s) and will be elected each semester.
