## Are you applying to transfer Fall 2016?

## If so, then it is critical that you schedule a follow-up appointment ASAP so we can verify the following:

- 1. You will have the 60 transferable units completed by the end of the spring semester
- 2. Identify what major prep requirements you have left to complete for your schools of choice
- 3. Identify what general education requirements you have left to complete
- 4. Identify if you are eligible for an AA degree
- 5. Identify your transferable GPA
- 6. Identify the colleges you are applying to

The filing period for the **CSU's is October 1-November 30th** and for the **UC's it is No-vember 1-30th**. Don't wait till the last minute to apply, you can create your CSU appli-

We will have a mandatory meeting for all students applying this fall. The **Transition Meeting will be Monday, October 6th from 1-2 pm, room TBA**. We will discuss the application process in detail and answer any questions you might have.

Prior to Attending the workshop, you should:

1) Read TAG conditions at your preferred University to determine initial eligibility;

- 2) Obtain transcripts from ALL previous colleges/universities;
- Log in and create an account <u>https://uctag.universityofcalifornia.edu/;</u>
- 4) Complete the <u>TAG application</u> to the best of your ability— academic history should <u>mirror</u> your transcripts,

#### i.e. show all courses-non-transferable, D's, F's, W's, repeats, etc.; and

5) Please **be on time** for the TAG workshop as the information relayed takes the full class. If you expect to be more than 5—10 minutes late, please plan on attending another workshop. Remember to bring your transcripts and have your planned courses for spring 2015 (you may need to meet with an academic counselor prior to the workshop).
