Article I - Name

The Name of Club will be: South Asian Student Union (SASU)

Article II – Purpose of the Club

The club has been organized to promote unity, cultural awareness, and community among South Asian students and allies at SBCC. We strive to celebrate South Asian heritage through cultural, educational, and social events, and provide an inclusive space for collaboration and friendship.

Article III – Authority

The Club derives its authority directly from the Student Senate and indirectly from the College Board of Trustees.

Article IV – Membership (Mandatory)

Membership is open to all SBCC students regardless of their religious affiliations, gender, age, sexual orientation, ethnicity, etc.

Article V – Meetings

Regular meetings of the Club will be determined by the membership at its initial meeting each semester and reported to the Office of Student Life, room CC 217.

Article VI - Officers

- President Preside over all meetings and call special meetings and manage Social
 Media
- Vice President Supports the President, assists in planning, and takes over in their absence.
- Secretary Records minutes of club meetings, manages communications, and maintains membership records.
- **Treasurer** Keeps financial records and manages the club's funds.

Article VII - Elections

Officers shall serve **one academic year term** and will be elected each **fall semester** by majority vote of the members present.

Article VIII - Amendments

The Constitution shall be amended upon the approval of **two-thirds (66%)** of the Club members.
